


"HAUN TABATA," a co-living rental place that emphasizes comfortable living, opened on March 1st.

About HAUN

"HAUN" is a co-living rental property that prioritizes comfortable living. Collaborating with architects, we've designed spaces that exude a sense of comfort, incorporating abundant greenery to evoke a natural touch. Our space design allows for the perception of sunlight and wind, striking a perfect balance of proximity and privacy. Even in the heart of the city, our aim is to provide a lifestyle where each resident can experience their own version of "comfortable" living.

Features of HAUN TABATA

1. Natural texture

All of HAUN's properties strive for interior designs that allow residents to experience greenery and natural sunlight. Even in the heart of the city, residents can enjoy a healthy lifestyle while feeling the presence of nature.

2. Just the right balance

Living at HAUN strikes a balance where the distance between people is neither too close nor too far. The space design considers a new proximity and relationship with those living nearby, distinct from both highly communal living and solitary living.

3. Thoughtful interior design

HAUN's design prioritizes the comfort of living over traditional approaches to communal housing. Collaborating with our architectural partners, we meticulously design common areas, including layout and furniture, to ensure that every resident feels 'comfortable' down to the smallest detail."

*"Co-living" refers to residences that combine two characteristics: "residence" and "workspace," where individuals can share living and working spaces. According to a report by the comprehensive real estate service company JLL, there is a growing demand for co-living spaces as telecommuting becomes more established due to the influence of the pandemic, leading to an increasing trend of incorporating work into daily life. Additionally, a survey by Japan Net Bank found that approximately 57% of millennials are interested in "new ways of living" that are not bound by homeownership or rental housing, compared to 37% of the older generation. This highlights the differences in values towards lifestyle among generations. In other words, amid the establishment of telecommuting as a "way of working" and the desire for a lifestyle free from homeownership or rental constraints as a "way of living," co-living rentals are gaining attention as a new lifestyle choice offering a blend of both trends.

<Interior Design>

The interior design of HAUN aims for a gender-neutral, elegant, and relaxed color palette, based on wood, warm greige, and soft green tones. The furniture will feature simple designs that are approachable to everyone.

HAUN Architectural Partners:

Handling the design of the common areas at HAUN TABATA is HUNE Architects, based in Tokyo. Following that, HAUN OSAKI and HAUN KURAMAE, to be opened subsequently, will be designed by mok and &K architects, based in Copenhagen. Additionally, HUNE Architects will also be responsible for the upcoming HAUN OGU.

< Future Developments >

What HAUN aims to achieve is to provide the option of living in a city one might not have considered

before, through the brand. Additionally, it strives to create a space akin to a park in the heart of the city, where people from different backgrounds can comfortably reside. This sentiment is also reflected in the Danish word "HAUN," meaning "harbor." HAUN plans to continue opening properties primarily in Tokyo and eventually expand to major cities in other regions. By eliminating security deposits, key money, and brokerage fees, HAUN aims to alleviate the psychological barriers to relocation for its residents. HAUN will also introduce a system to facilitate "HAUN hopping," allowing residents to move confidently and lightly to explore cities they haven't lived in before.



About HAUN TABATA

HAUN's first building, HAUN TABATA, located in the serene residential neighborhood of Tabata, a 6-minute walk from JR Yamanote Line and Keihin-Tohoku Line "Tabata Station," will open its doors on Friday, March 1, 2024.

< Features of HAUN TABATA >

- 1. A light start to single living
 - No security deposit or key money, no brokerage fees, furnished with furniture and appliances, equipped with free WIFI and laundry facilities
 - Offers fixed-term building lease contracts with rental periods of 6 months, 1 year, and 2 years
- 2. Excellent accessibility:
 - A 6-minute walk from "Tabata Station" on the JR Yamanote Line and Keihin-Tohoku Line

- Outstanding access to various terminal stations
- 9 minutes to Ikebukuro Station, 14 minutes to Tokyo Station, 18 minutes to Shinjuku Station,
 and 25 minutes to Shibuya Station
- 3. Architecture focused on comfortable living
 - The common areas, flooded with natural light and abundant greenery, feature living dining spaces, workspaces, kitchens, and laundry areas.
